CatholicCare's Targeted Earlier Intervention Program provides case management and/or counselling services for young people and their families in Maitland, Cessnock and Gloucester.

Support offered varies depending on needs, but may include counselling, information and referral, and help with parenting concerns and troubles.

We promote family cohesion and create a supportive environment aimed at preventing issues for young people and their families from escalating.

Who can access CatholicCare's TEI program?

The service targets young people and their families in Maitland, Cessnock and Gloucester.

There are a few ways a young person or family can become involved.

- With permission, they can be referred by a community agency or a school.
- > They can self refer.

Participation in the program is voluntary.

The TEI Program is a free support service that comes at no cost to participants. It is funded by the NSW Government Department of Communities and Justice.
